## Donations Needed for Soup Kitchen

**For the past month, Mrs Cowell has been helping as a volunteer at a soup kitchen, helping feed the homeless in her home town of Blackburn.**

Community Spirit is the charity that organises the work and they set up in 2014. Around 60 vulnerable people use the service every week and up to 30 volunteers lend a hand with providing free hot and cold food, toiletries, sleeping bags, other items and haircuts. Without Community Spirit's work, some of the vulnerable clients would not make it through the winter and they're very grateful for the help they receive.

The soup kitchen runs entirely as a result of donations from the public and local businesses and they have managed to feed people every single

Tuesday night since they began. Whilst donations of food, toiletries and sleeping bags are always really gratefully received by the organisers and volunteers, they desperately need plastic forks and spoons; small paper or plastic sandwich bags; paper or plastic cups; the polystyrene boxes seen in the photograph; kitchen roll and plastic gloves.
